# 2017 Harvest

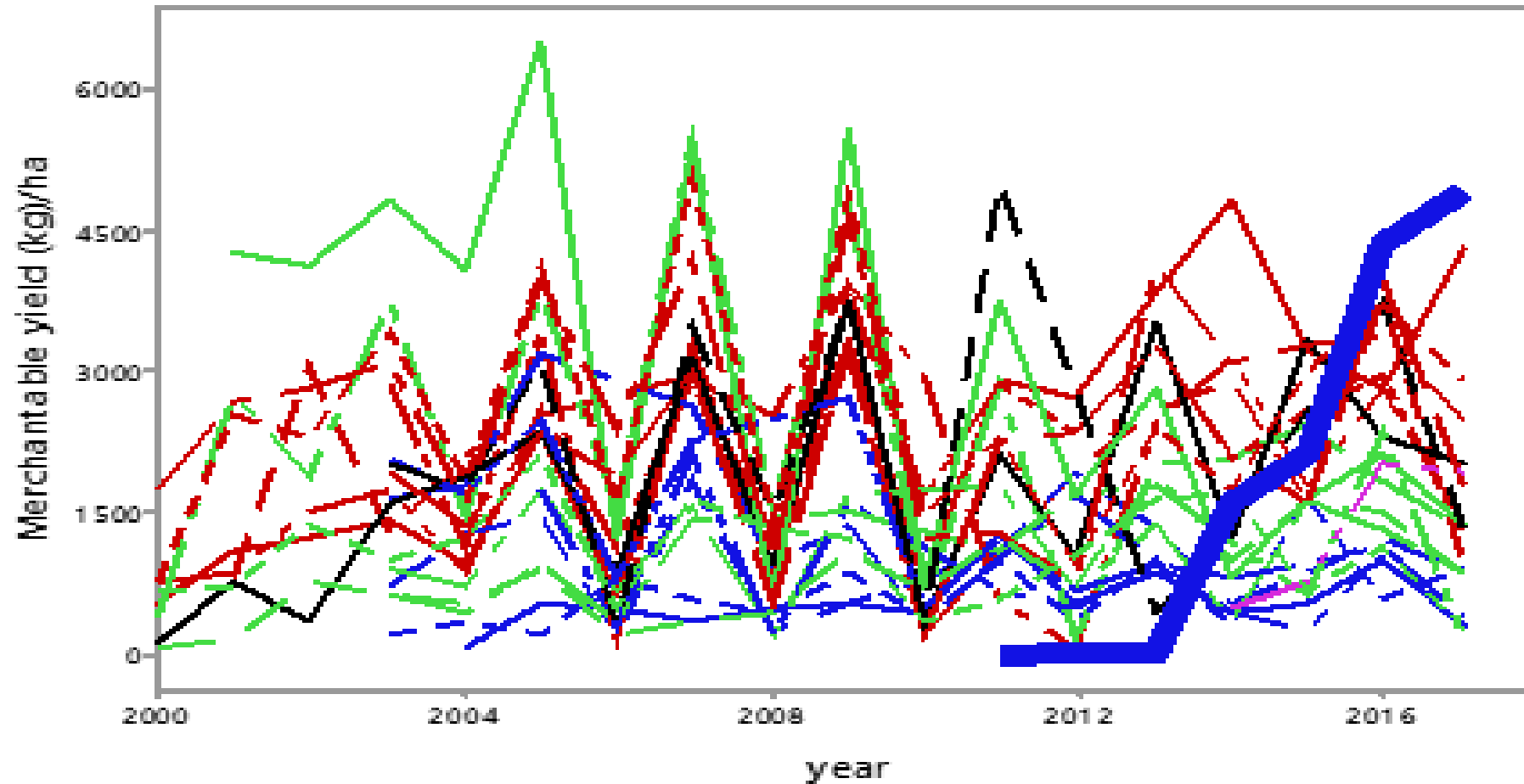
- The on and off crops seem to have flipped.  
The even years now seem to be the on-crop with odd years becoming the off-crop.
- 2017 was generally a good off-crop.

2017	<b>1,510</b> tonnes
2016	<b>1,920</b> tonnes
2015	<b>1,700</b> tonnes

# 2017 Harvest

- 2017 nut size very large
  - 2017 **79** nuts per 100gms
  - 2016 **92** nuts per 100gms
  - 2015 **94** nuts per 100gmsSupermarket requirements 85/100gms
- Dark Stain very high
  - 2017 **10.7%**
  - 2016 **1.8%**
  - 2015 **7.1%**

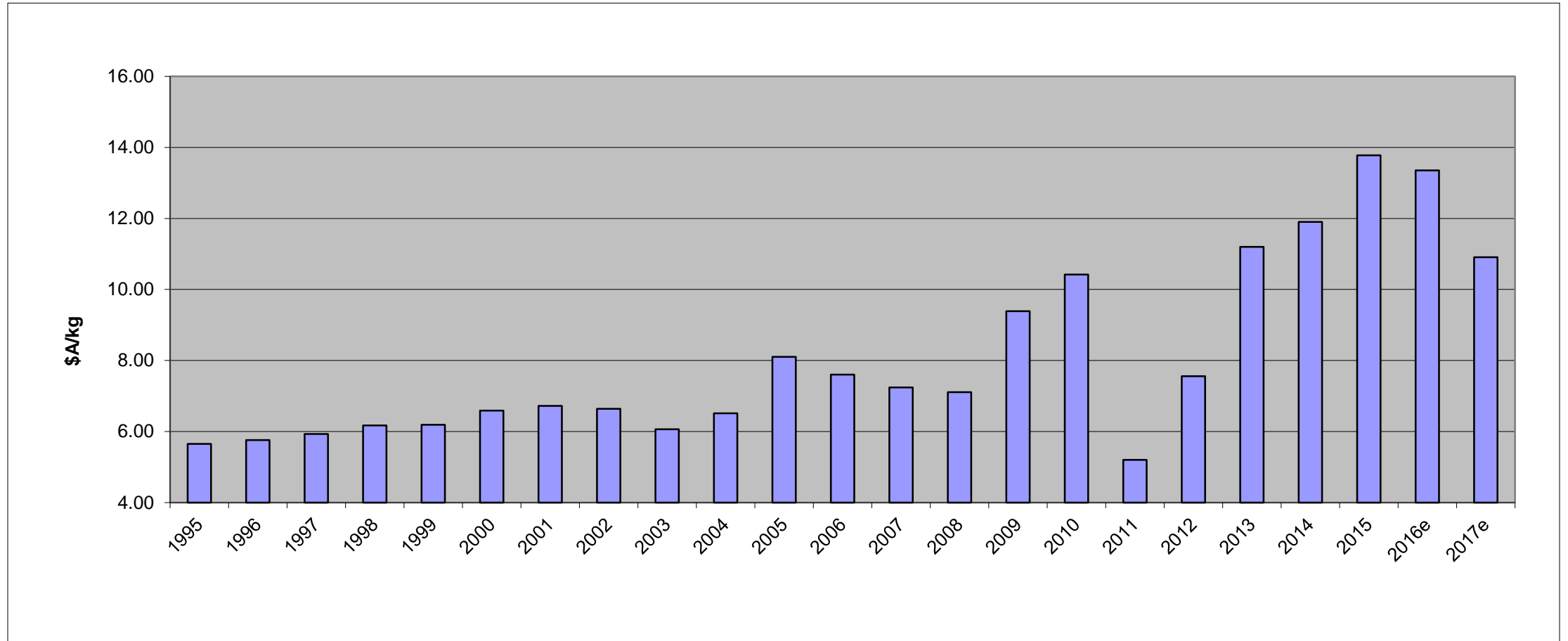


# 2017 Prices
