



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

TO CONTROL CAROB MOTH IN PISTACHIO NUT CROPS

PERMIT NUMBER - PER14308

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

SUCCESS NEO INSECTICIDE

Containing: 120 g/L SPINETORAM as its only active constituent.

DELEGATE INSECTICIDE

Containing: 250 g/kg SPINETORAM as its only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

PISTACHIO	CAROB MOTH (<i>Ectomyelois ceratoniae</i>)	<u>SUCCESS NEO INSECTICIDE:</u> 1 L/ha <u>DELEGATE INSECTICIDE:</u> 500 g/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- At the beginning of the season, carefully monitor for eggs and larvae by regular field scouting.
- Application timing is critical – the first application of an insecticide should be when 1-5% of the pistachio hulls are opening.
- Target sprays against mature eggs and newly hatched larvae.
- Follow-up application should occur when required.
- Ensure thorough spray coverage of all leaf and nut surfaces with a minimum rate of 1000 L water/ha using an airblast sprayer or equivalent.
- Add a non-ionic wetting agent at the recommended rate. DO NOT use a non-ionic wetting agent if mixing with other products.
- Practise orchard hygiene with removal of mummified fruit in winter.
- DO NOT apply more than two (2) applications of *Success Neo* or *Delegate* per season with a minimum retreatment interval of seven (7) days between consecutive applications.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT harvest for 7 DAYS after final spray application.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
