



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

**FOR THE CONTROL OF
BOTRYTIS ROT AND ALTERNARIA LEAF SPOT
IN PISTACHIOS**

PERMIT NUMBER – PER80806

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

CORVETTE FLOWABLE FUNGICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L IPRODIONE as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Diseases	Rate
Pistachio nuts	Botrytis rot (<i>Botrytis cinerea</i>) and Alternaria leaf spot (<i>Alternaria alternata</i>)	1L product /ha. Use 50mL/100L water

Critical Use Comments:

- Resistance to iprodione can develop readily:
 - DO NOT apply more than three (3) applications per season.
 - DO NOT apply more than 2 iprodione sprays consecutively.
- Further treatment should be made using a fungicide with an alternative mode-of-action (e.g. non Group-B).
- Thorough coverage is essential.

Botrytis cinerea control:

- Apply as a thorough cover spray to flower racemes when they open.
- A follow-up spray may be needed one week later if wet conditions persist during flowering.

Alternaria alternata control:

- Apply during nut development, prior to nut split.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT harvest for 21 DAYS after application.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES except Victoria

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC).

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

Export of produce:

To allow treated produce to be supplied or otherwise made available for human consumption Temporary Maximum Residue Limits (TMRL) have been established for Iprodione covering the commodity Pistachio nut at 0.2mg/kg. This MRL applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. If treated produce is to be exported, due account should therefore be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.
